



Guidelines - Criteria for National Prominence

1. Service as an Editor or on Editorial Boards of peer-reviewed journals;
2. Membership on site visit teams for national funding agencies, e.g. NICHD, NCI, CDC, CIHR, MOD;
3. Regular participation in peer-review activities for national funding agencies (see above) and/or professional peer-reviewed journals;
4. Convening/organizing programs at national or international meetings of significant professional organizations;
5. Selection for membership in appropriate selective prestigious national or international academic/scholarly professional organizations;
6. Elected leadership role in prestigious regional or national or international academic/scholarly professional organizations;
7. Honors or awards from prestigious national or international academic/scholarly professional organizations.
8. Significant leadership or committee service to prestigious national or international academic/scholarly professional organizations.
9. Academic leadership positions (e.g. Dean, Chairmanship or Division Director).
